At the symposium:

To access the conference site you need to be recovered, full vaccinated, or tested negative!

We will check your status during the registration. Please bring your proofs along.

If you are neither recovered nor fully vaccinated you need to show a negative test every morning (test must not be older than 48 hours). There are test centers nearby the conference venue. They offer tests free of charge. You will receive the results via e-mail approximately half an hour after the test. The conference office will help you booking tests.


